# Order of the Night

"Holy, Holy, is the LORD of armies. The whole earth is full of His glory." – Isaiah 6:3 (NASB)

This is a sacred time set apart to glorify God, celebrate His goodness, and seek His presence. Tonight, we lay aside titles, ministries, and roles to focus solely on ministering to the Lord. Below is the Order of the Night—a guide to help us worship with freedom, reverence, and unity.

- 1. Lay It All at the Door Come simply as worshipers, setting aside titles and roles to minister to the Lord.
- 2. **Worship with Freedom and Humility** Express your love for God through singing, dancing, or silence, but always with reverence.
- 3. **Sing with Abandon** Lift your voice in song, letting the Spirit lead your worship.
- 4. **Be Led by the Spirit** Allow the Holy Spirit to move freely, guiding our worship and intercession.
- 5. **Honor the Spirit and One Another** Worship boldly but with humility, ensuring an atmosphere of unity.
- 6. **Pray as the Lord Leads** Let intercession rise as we seek His presence and His will.
- 7. **Come and Go as the Lord Leads** Enter and exit with reverence, ensuring the atmosphere of worship remains undisturbed.
- 8. **Seek God's Presence Above All Else** Let every act of worship tonight be for His glory alone.

Come expectant. Come hungry. Come ready to encounter the presence of God.
